To Colin, Bill and Jim -my thanks for your help and support.


To all the young juniors who supplied all the fun one could get throughout the season. Also to all the referees, without your support and friendship it would make this year very hard.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

Dear Members,

It is with great pleasure I present to you, the 1996 Annual Report and Balance Sheet. In this report I have tried to compile an accurate reflection of the state of the Association. Unfortunately, as like last year the Association was left without a major sponsor but as you will see from the Balance Sheet later in the report the Association is financially sound. Hopefully in the new year we will have good news regarding a long term sponsor.

The year got off to a flying start with the Annual NSW Referees Golf Day over the Australia Day Holiday. First off it would be remiss of me not to congratulate Canterbury Referees Association on winning the Main Trophy. Also thanks should be given to our Golf Captain, Stephen Clark, for his hard work in getting a team together.

As has been the practice over the last few years the on-field side of refereeing started early this year with Representative Trials held at Macquarie University. Thank you to all the referees who made themselves available, especially considering the weather factors.

1996 saw the continuing trend in the North Sydney Junior League of a fall in the amount of sides competing in the age groups U/7's to U/19's. This caused the Junior League in the age groups U/14's to U/19's to send the sides down to play in the Manly area. Also with the demise of the A2 competition, this left the Junior League with only two complete grades on every Sunday with the rest of the games made up of home games from the Manly competitions. This unfortunately meant some referees had to miss out on a centre, but on the bright side led to more active competition and I believe and improvement in standard of our referees. 1997 sees a number of changes to the Junior League competition. The most significant being the transfer of Sunday football to Saturday, i.e A Grade to U14, the exception being joint competitions where they will be played as per usual. Also A grade will be reduced from 40 minutes each way to 35 and A Res from 35 to 30 minutes each way. These measures will hopefully help to bring back more players to Rugby League in 1997.

I will say only a few words about 'Super League' in my report. At the time of writing this report it looks like there will be two Rugby League competitions running in parallel in the 1997 season. This Association is in the lucky situation of having referees participating in both competitions. It has been always the wish of this Association not to favour either side but to look after the best interests of all of its members. Even though our District Club is ARL aligned the Association disagreed with it and the Junior League when they excluded certain members from refereeing in 1995 as it disadvantaged our members. Also the composition of our Executive Committee I believe reflects the attitude of the members, with both ARL and Super League aligned referees holding senior positions and working together constructively to further Rugby League in the North Sydney area. The last thing this Association needs are members forming little groups, whether ARL or Super League, inside the Association and undermining the successful running of the Association.

Regardless of affiliation we are 'ALL NORTH SYDNEY DISTRICT REFEREES.'

This year saw the Association hold a number of Social Events which are written in more detail later in the report, but I believe one should be mentioned here. The Annual Dinner meeting, where we saw John Quinn honoured for 50 years involvement in Rugby League. John has been a stalwart of our Association over the years but I believe more importantly he has been a friend and confidante to a great many of our members. I believe if every member of this Association and the Junior League and District Club looks back over there career in football or even their life outside football they would find plenty of occasions where John has been there to give a helping hand or just be there to listen. I believe the nickname 'Father Quinn' John is known as covers it very well. On behalf of the members, thank you, for being there and we all hope that you and Mary are around for many years to come.

At this time I would like to thank a few people and organisations for their help throughout this year and proceeding ones:

To Malcolm Woodcock, Wayne Lambkin and the Board of Management of the Junior League, congratulations on the completion of a successful year.








